This project aims to enhance youth interactions with the natural world by making free tree seedlings available to youth who individually or as part of a group commit to planting and caring for at least one tree.

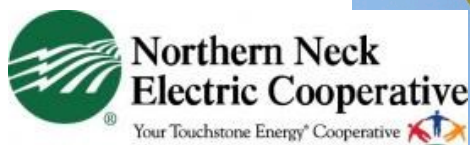
As this happens, we will improve our community's environment and next generation.
